1.1 REPRESENTATION REVIEW WORKSHOP

1. PURPOSE

For councillors to provide initial feedback on the representation review options. These options will be further developed by council officers for the next workshop.

Stephen Hill from ElectioNZ facilitated the workshop.

The key question related to this phase of the representation review is whether or not there is fair and effective representation of communities of interest within Carterton.

The key areas discussed were:

- The number of councillors
- Whether the basis of election is 'at large' (over the whole district), using wards, or a mixed system of representation using both wards and councillors being elected 'at large'.
- Should community boards be introduced.
