6.1 WATER RACE REPORT

1. PURPOSE

To provide the Water Race Committee with an update on the management of the Water Races.

NOTED

- A new intake structure will be installed into the Carrington intake when there is low flow.
- Run off from roads and properties goes into the Water Race. Lawrence will send the stormwater water race water quality results (that discharge into a water race) to the Committee. The majority of pipes to the Waikakariki stream, Mangatarere or Booths Creek, and approximately a quarter of the town stormwater discharges to the Rutland Road branch.
- Stormwater for the state highway is managed by a separate consent with Waka Kotahi. With Local Water Done Well it is not clear who will manage the stormwater consent and maintenance it could be the new Water Service Entity, the CDC Roading team, or the Water Race team.
- GWRC will publicly notify the application on the Water Race Consent in a few months' time. There was discussion that Water Race ratepayers need to be engaged with this consultation. The communications team will look at an engagement plan to encourage ratepayers to make a submission.

6.2 QUARTERLY WATER QUALITY REPORT

1. PURPOSE

For the Committee to be informed about water quality in the water races.

NOTED

- The Water Race was originally set up to provide water for stock. A key principle of the Water Races is that clean running water is available to the end users farmers who use it for stock.
- Some users upstream (e.g. Norfolk Nursery) access the water race. As part of the Waingawa Process Water Proiect, water race water will be accessed and stored.
- There was discussion that when the Waingawa Process Water Project is operational, that in times of low flow, Water Race water is prioritised for stock, and industrial users use other back-up options.
