1.1 ANNUAL PLAN 2025/26 WORKSHOP

1. PURPOSE

To review budgets and fees and charges as part of developing the Annual Plan 2025/26.

Discussion

- All the funding from Year 2 of the LTP has been re-forecast.
- The draft proposed rates in Year 2 has reduced from 13% to 8.7%.
- There are no new capital projects for next year. All of the current new capital projects are in this financial year.
 - o The Process Water Projects has been included in the LTP.
 - The Water Storage Project under discussion is not currently included.
- As a result of re-forecasting, the key visible changes to the LTP are:
 - o Removed inflation (resulted in a decrease)
 - Reconciled NZTA funding to include funding changes and an inflation adjustment (resulted in a decrease)
 - Undertook a critical review of Opex for Three Waters (resulted in a decrease)
 - Reviewed insurance forecast in premiums (resulted in a small increase)
 - Reforecast capital expenditure (resulted in a decrease)

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- Reforecast loans, repayments and interest rates on new loans (resulted in an increase)
- There has been a critical review of operating costs and creation of an Event Centre activity
- Further changes for consideration are:
 - A forestry consultant / Forestry rate cost estimate \$40k Opex
 - LWDW Transition and implementation options (If joining with Tararua District Council and SWDC and MDC) - a quarter share for CDC is \$1.25M Capex
 - Water Race apprentice 1.0 FTE Opex
 - Road seal extension budget TBC
 - Additional costs for Combined Wairarapa Emergency Management \$30K Opex
 - Reset MTFJ and expand to be an internal model TBC
 - o The overhead allocation model has been updated
- The draft Annual Plan 2025/26 is expected to be a completed by 30 April, and is planned to go to the Risk and Assurance Committee meeting on 7 May for endorsement, and the Council meeting on 14 May 2025 for adoption.

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
